Building works



As you may have noticed, the school are having some building work completed. We are unable to use the usual gate throughout this time. All children will be arriving through the large gate at near the cul-de-sac island. Staff will open the gate at 8.50am to enable children to wait in a safe environment ready for when nursery opens at 9.00am. Parents will be invited onto the playground at 11.45am or 3.15pm through the same gate and children will then be brought out through door they entered nursery. If you need to contact either Ms Gordon or Mrs Hanna then please call the office or ask a member of staff and they will come round and meet you. We are trying to limit any inconvenience to our families and thank you for your cooperation at this time. A full risk assessment has been completed on the impact of building works as well the changes to our arrival and departures from nursery, which is available to view in the office.
